Winning With Wyatt has donated more than \$550,000 to support pediatric brain tumor research

CHICAGO, March 12, 2021 – Winning With Wyatt has announced a \$90,000 donation to the Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital to support pediatric brain tumor research. The funding was made possible through the generous contributions as part of Winning With Wyatt's 2020 fundraising efforts, including the Virtual Benefit Concert for Hope streamed on Facebook Live in September.

"On behalf of the Winning With Wyatt foundation, the families involved in the foundation and it's many supporters, it is our honor to present the Brain Tumor Center with this donation of \$90,000," said Kim and Dan Hare, founders of Winning With Wyatt. "In collaboration with the Children's Brain Tumor Network, the team of physician-scientists at Lurie Children's are doing incredible work to research new treatment and improve the standard of care for pediatric brain cancer. We hope this donation will play a role in ultimately finding a cure for pediatric brain tumors."

Brain tumors are the leading cause of cancer death in children. In the last 40 years, the standard treatment protocol for most pediatric brain tumors has not significantly changed, and only two new drugs have been specifically developed to treat children with cancer in the last 20 years. Despite those facts, only 4% of federal research funding is designated to pediatric cancer which makes funding research for new treatments so critically important.

Winning With Wyatt supports pediatric brain tumor research at leading institutions to find a cure for the disease that is the leading cause of cancer deaths in children. The foundation is also dedicated to building awareness of the impact brain tumors have on children and advocating for more advanced treatment.
